- Assist in the development and maintenance of application specific documentation and guides and knowledge transfer sessions for smooth handover to operational teams
- Ensure compliance to SDLC methodology and audit controls
- Maintain KPI's & metrics for project/product work streams with an objective to improve efficiency, throughput and quality
